

SPECIAL MEETING DES MOINES CITY COUNCIL

MINUTES

March 14, 2002

The special meeting of the Des Moines City Council was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by Mayor Wasson in the City Hall Conference Room, 21630 11th Avenue South.

ROLL CALL – Present: Mayor Don Wasson (left the meeting at 6:47 p.m. & returned to the meeting at 7:10 p.m.), Mayor Pro Tem Richard Benjamin, Councilmembers Gary Petersen (arrived at 7:10 p.m.), Bob Sheckler, Maggie Steenrod (arrived at 7:10 p.m.), Scott Thomasson, and Susan White. Also present were Assistant City Manager Tony Piasecki, City Attorney Gary McLean and Public Works Director Tim Heydon (left at 7:07 p.m.).

Mayor Wasson announced that Council would hold an Executive Session for approximately 30 minutes to discuss real estate matters, about which public knowledge might have an adverse impact on price to the detriment of the City.

At 6:47 p.m., Mayor Wasson recused himself from the meeting.

At 7:10 p.m., Mayor Wasson returned to the room and Councilmembers Petersen and Steenrod joined the meeting.

City Attorney McLean announced that the City Council would hold an Executive Session for approximately 30 minutes to discuss with legal counsel representing the City litigation or potential litigation to which the City is, or is likely to become, a party and about which public knowledge regarding the discussion is likely to result in an adverse legal or financial consequence to the City.

No formal action was taken.
