

SPECIAL MEETING DES MOINES CITY COUNCIL

MINUTES

March 28, 2002

The special meeting of the Des Moines City Council was called to order at 6:36 p.m. by Mayor Wasson in the City Hall Conference Room, 21630 11th Avenue South.

ROLL CALL - Present: Mayor Don Wasson, Councilmembers Gary Petersen, Bob Sheckler, Maggie Steenrod, Scott Thomasson and Susan White. Absent: Mayor Pro Tem Richard Benjamin. Also present were Acting City Manager Tony Piasecki, City Attorney Gary McLean, Cabott Dow (left meeting at 7:20 p.m.) and Community Development Director Judith Kilgore (arrived at 7:20 p.m. and left at 7:45 p.m.).

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING PROCESS
