

SPECIAL MEETING DES MOINES CITY COUNCIL

MINUTES

April 4, 2002

The special meeting of the Des Moines City Council was called to order at 6:37 p.m. by Mayor Wasson in the City Hall Conference Room, 21630 11th Avenue South.

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING PROCESS

Mayor Wasson announced that the Council would hold an Executive Session for approximately 30 minutes for the purpose of planning or adopting strategies or positions as part of an ongoing collective bargaining process.
