

SPECIAL MEETING DES MOINES CITY COUNCIL

MINUTES

June 27, 1996

The special meeting of the Des Moines City Council was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Brazil at 7:05 p.m. in the City Hall Conference Room.

PRESENT: Mayor Pro Tem Terry Brazil, Councilmembers Bob Sheckler, Dan Sherman, Gary Towe, and Don Wasson. Also present were City Manager Bob Olander, City Attorney Gary McLean, Public Works Director Tim Heydon, Assistant City Engineer Loren Reinhold, Chief of Police Don Obermiller, Lieutenant John O'Leary, Lieutenant Kevin Tucker, Police Officer Charles Pardee, and Community Service Officer Lead Shelley Miell.

The Mayor Pro Tem announced that the City Council will hold an Executive Session for approximately 30 minutes for the purpose of discussing 1) the acquisition of real estate by purchase and about which public knowledge would cause a likelihood of increased price; and 2) law enforcement activities about which public knowledge regarding the discussion could result in adverse consequences to the City.

At 7:30 p.m., the Executive Session ended, the Council returned to open session, and adjourned the special meeting. No formal action was taken.
