	The State of Mount Rainier High School • 1700 students enrolled – this is more than previous years. • All admin staff from last year returned this year. • Highline School District continues to utilize in school suspensions as an alternative method to the more traditional out of school suspensions. Safety and Security Planning • Emergency response plan for the Highline School District was update last school year. This was the first update in approximately 10 years. • School admin, school security and School Resource Officer Chevallier have monthly safety and security meetings. • Mt. Rainier High School participated in Shake Out Drill on 10/18. • Works with school admin and security to ensure safety of the students and staff. • Communicates with other School Resource Officers at other schools and in other districts on topics affecting schools in the region. Traffic and Roadway Planning • Roadway construction on S 223 St impacted traffic around the school. • School Resource Officer Chevallier reviews speed zone violates and issues infractions. • Des Moines Elementary traffic was reviewed in September after a complaint was filed. More lane dilators were installed to prevent vehicles from making unsafe and illegal U-turns in front of the school. The pick-up / drop-off location was extended. A letter was sent to all families advising them of the pick-up / drop off procedures.
