 - a. Councilmembers Bangs, and Mahoney present

2. Consideration of Dec 3, 2020 PSEM minutes
 - a. Motion made to approve minutes by Councilmember Mahoney, seconded by Bangs, motion passed
3. Significant Actions in 2020 reduced due to Covid
 - a. Chief Thomas updated the committee on actions that were planned in 2020 by the Police Department, but because of the Covid Pandemic were cancelled or put on hold.

Temporarily redeployed officers assigned to Pro-Active Special Investigations and Street Crimes Division. Unable to conduct Hotel 'John' Stings, Metro Bus Line Operations, Pro-active Drug Stings, etc.

Temporarily eliminated Community Outreach programs (e.g. Community Meetings, Coffee with a Cop)

Significantly reduced all "in office" services, including CPL renewals and fingerprinting services

 - a. Committee Reviewed Draft work plan
 - i. Vaccination Update was moved from April to February
 - ii. A discussion on SRO's was added for September
